MEETING MODIFICATION DUE TO COVID-19 Pursuant to Governor Pritzker Executive Orders 2020-07 and 2020-39 which suspends the requirement of the Illinois Open Meetings Act requiring in-person attendance by members of a public body during the duration of the Gubernatorial Disaster Proclamation, the members of the City Council will be participating in the meeting through a video and audio access using the virtual meeting platform, Microsoft Teams. Anyone in excess of 10 people will be asked to wait in another room with live feed to the meeting until the agenda item for which the person or persons would like to speak on is being discussed or until the open floor for public comments. All public comments must be received by 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 7, 2020.
