Fire Hiring Update

Four offers have been made and have completed their pre-employment tests just waiting on receiving all results to set a start date. One offer was made after one candidate dropped out of the pre-employment process but hoping his pre-employment tests will be completed in the next couple of weeks. There was discussion regarding the ease to obtain a CPAT as many candidates on the eligibility register were passed over due to not having a valid CPAT at the time of conditional offer so they will get one more chance.

Police Hiring Update

Mark Gaspar will graduate the academy on August 24, 2023. The board received a request for hire from Commissioner Ganiere due to the resignation of Nicholas Pagan. This adds to a previous request for a total of two open positions within the Police Department. At this time, the list for entry level positions has been exhausted and a lateral eligibility register has not been established due to a lack of applications in prior requests to accept applications. There is an academy in September but there will not be a new hire ready for that academy and the next academy after that is in December. At the time of the meeting, there were no applications received for lateral transfers, but the board is accepting applications through September 8th. There have been three inquiries, but none have submitted applications as of date.

Police Testing

The board determined to continue with the remote testing for entry level patrol officers. The application will go live August 14, 2023. There will be 6 weeks of advertising and the remote test will be available September 25 through September 29, 2023. Oral interviews are scheduled for October 10, 2023.

Police Promotional Testing

Testing for Sergeant is underway, and the test is scheduled for September 21, 2023. Ken will follow up with Carol and LETA to see how the test creation process is coming along.

Rules Amendment

The Board will amend its rules as follows:

CHAPTER IV - PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATIONS*

SECTION 1: Police Department

F. In order to be eligible for promotion to rank of Corporal patrolman must meet the minimum qualification of three years of active consecutive service within the Ottawa Police Department from the date of hire on or before applications are closed for promotion. Patrolman hired pursuant to the Lateral Transfer provisions of CHAPTER III, Section 2, shall be given credit for two (2) years of active consecutive service and will be eligible for promotion to the rank of Corporal upon successful completion of the twelve (12) month probationary period on or before applications are closed for promotion.

Moved by Steve Malinsky, second by Tim McTaggert to amend the rules and regulations of the board as stated above. All ayes. Motion passed.
