LEAF VACUUM ANNOUNCEMENT

October 24, 2024

The annual City leaf vacuum program will begin on Monday, November 4, 2024, in Areas N-1, S-1 and W-1. City leaf vacuum crews will proceed through Areas N-1 to N-4, Areas S-1 to S-4 and Areas W-1 to W-3 simultaneously. Once all areas are completed, the process will be repeated a second time in the same order.

Please make sure that leaf piles are free of sticks and other debris and are placed on the berm and <u>not</u> placed in the street or near storm drains or inlets.

After rain events leaves can clog storm drains causing flooding issues. Residents are advised to use caution when traveling on streets in these areas and to be aware for periodic road closures. Please drive slowly when passing City crews for their safety and yours.
