Meeting called to order at 4:13 p.m.

Public Comment – None.

Steve Burns advised the Commission that 320 Pedestal meters are not allowed by Ameren. Ameren requires a separate metal barrier not accessible to anyone other than the utility.

Steve Burns advised the Commission that underground service with no sweep in a vertical service, no expansion joint is required. If a sweep is installed for the utility, a large radius sweep is needed and an expansion joint.

Discussion regarding whole house surge protection.

Discussion regarding location of a 220-volt GFCI receptacle for cooking and A/C units.

Discussion regarding fireman's disconnect, online side of service.

Moved by John Paytk, second by Don Ganiere to approve the January 13, 2021 minutes as written. All ayes. Motion passed.

There are currently 508 current and 79 inactive electrical licenses.

Discussion regarding upcoming exams. The Electrical Inspector will produce exams with suggested questions pertaining to the 2020 NEC code changes, for each type of electrical license the City issues. Computer Spa and Electrical Inspector will electronically mail these suggested changes to all Electrical Commission members and the Building Official, and Steve Burns. These exams will be sent securely, they cannot be printed/ altered/copied by anyone just reviewed. At the June 23, 2021 meeting we will entertain comments and hopefully approve / modify the exams we are currently using to incorporate the 2020 Changes.
