Moved by Don Ganiere, second by John Paytk, to approve the December 15, 2021 minutes as written. All ayes. Motion passed.

Discussion regarding cost of annual renewal of license, and/or exam fees be adjusted to reflect varied fee amounts to clarify what the payment is for (\$148- \$152 example).

Discussion: Currently up to 12 months allowed to pay your electrical license fees, w/ penalty. Should this time frame be shorter in length?

Status of City Council amending Chapter 22 as recommended by the Electrical commission at the December 15, 2021 meeting:

1. MC (Metal Clad) cable exceptions should be matched in the AC (Armour clad) cable part of Chap 22. AC and MC exceptions should be the same.
2. NM<sup>TM</sup> type cable may be used in Dwelling units up to SIX units, Maximum
3. NM type cable can be used in Dwelling units up to and including Three Stories, Maximum

Status – is online code of Chapter 22 up to date.

Electrical exam M6 was reviewed, and updates suggested.
