Solar Contractor Update: one local electrical contractor subbed to Solar Installation contractor with no issues or concerns.

The amendment to City Ordinance Chapter 22 regarding the below issues is in progress with City Officials.

1. MC (Metal Clad) cable exceptions should be matched in the AC (Armour clad) cable part of Chap 22. AC and MC exceptions should be the same.
2. NM type cable may be used in Dwelling units up to SIX units, Maximum
3. NM type cable can be used in Dwelling units up to and including Three Stories, Maximum

Ameren Representative Dan Klein requests that the City ordinance reflect the use of PVC riser into utility meter as an alternative to rigid metal conduit (RMC), with expansion joint if required.

The cost adjustment to the electrical exam fee has been request to City officials for review.
