### 6. Old Business

The language to be introduced and approved for Section 22-168-270 (A) (1) of the Municipal Code is as follows:

- a. The electrical service disconnects for one- and two-family dwellings shall be installed in a readily accessible location on the outside of the dwelling/s.
- b. The electrical service disconnect for all other occupancies shall be installed at a readily accessible location on the outside of the building or structure, at a readily accessible location inside the building or structure within 3.0 M (10 feet) of the point of entrance of the service conductors.

#### 7. New Business

- a. The City Council has approved the hiring of a third Electrical Inspector, Brian Benavides of Ottawa.
- b. Community Development Legal has determined that there shall be no refunds for fees that have been paid for Electrical Permits. However, if a project or job has been cancelled, that fee can be applied to another job.

## 6. OLD BUSINESS:

The Residential Exam for the 2023 National Electrical Code was reviewed. It was determined that some of the questions need to be changed or reworded. The Electrical Inspectors shall update the exam with the changes.

### 7. NEW BUSINESS:

The Commission was presented with a situation in which the Electrical Inspectors believe needs to be corrected. A City Ordinance regarding service disconnects on electrical services conflicts with the requirements with Ameren Illinois Power Company. After a discussion, it was determined that the City Code (Section 22-168-270(A)(1) needs to be rewritten so there is no confusion for contractors when installing new electrical services. The City Code shall be rewritten and presented at the next regular meeting.
