Certificate of Appropriateness 317-319 Congress Street. Joshua Liddle, the homeowner, spoke on behalf of the project. His parents live in the adjacent unit, and he purchase the home in October of 2023. The porch needed railings and reinforcement, so he decided to enclose the porch. He planned to paint the enclosure white, matching the home, but stopped after receiving a stop work order. He was unaware that a permit was needed or that he was in a historic district.

Chuck noted that the porch windows differ from the upper windows. Joshua explained that he opted for smaller windows because he has a small toddler and wanted to avoid full length windows.

George noted that the house siding is not original.
