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CITY OF OTTAWA SEWER DEPARTMENT **CONNECTION FEES**

RESIDENTIAL:

- Single Family Home - \$525.00 (rated at 3.5 P.E)
- Townhouse/Condo/Duplex - \$525.00 per unit (rated at 3.5 P.E.)
- Apartment
 - Efficiency or studio apartment - \$150.00 (rated at 1 P.E.)
 - One Bedroom - \$225.00 (rated at 1.5 P.E.)
 - Two Bedroom - \$337.50 (rated at 2.25 P.E.)
 - Three Bedroom - \$450.00 (rated at 3 P.E.)
- Mobile Home - \$337.50 (rated at 2.25 P.E.)
 - Fee is based on P.E. usage. (1 P.E. = \$150.00)

COMMERCIAL:

- Commercial and industrial buildings are calculated according to the P.E. they expect to produce. The P.E. and sewer connection fee are computed as part of the building permit process.
 - An example: A restaurant with seating capacity of 84 is rated at 21.84 P.E. and will have a connection fee of \$3,276.00
